Gharda Foundation has also taken various projects for empowering the under-privileged and improving the living conditions of the weaker section of the society.

INTRODUCTION

In accordance with Section 135 of the Companies Act, 2013 and Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013, the Company's Corporate Social Responsibility Policy (CSR) is enunciated hereunder:

OUR CSR POLICY

Gharda Chemical Limited shall strive to reach out to the under-privileged, needy and weaker sections of the society and to address the social, educational, cultural, environmental and economic needs of such sections of the Society. The company shall give preference to the local area of its operations.

OBJECTIVES

Our objectives shall be within the framework of the Companies Act, 2013 as amended from time to time.

KEY AREAS WHICH WILL BE COVERED UNDER THE COMPANY'S CSR POLICY

4. Programmes to address malnutrition and sanitation
5. Immunization programmes on a thrust on polio eradication
6. Health care for visually impaired and differently abled

RESPONSIBILITIES

The CSR Committee will be responsible for

5. Review of the CSR Policy at least once in a year

BUDGET PROVISION

The total Budget for the CSR Projects will be recommended to the Board by the CSR Committee. For this the CSR Committee shall meet in the beginning of each year and review, recommend the CSR programmes identified and allocation of funds for approval of the Board.

TREATMENT OF SURPLUSES

Any surplus generated from CSR Projects undertaken by the company will be tracked and channelized into CSR Corpus. These funds will be further used in the development of the CSR projects and will not be added to the normal business profits.
